## IMPORTANT INFORMATION & EXPECTATIONS:

- Each routine should be prepared to meet between 4-8 times with your choreographer, depending on complexity and the dancers rate of learning.
- Dancers are expected to perform their piece for their classes each week for practice, but it's not time for questions or corrections from your teachers.
- Not all solos will be chosen and Abigail reserves the right to group dancers according to dance ability and style to best represent AFDS.

## LESSON FEE STRUCTURE:

Solo: \$60/hour (free to unlimited students)

Duets: \$80/hour (\$40 each)

Trios: \$99/hour (\$33 each)

Solo: \$120

Duets: \$60 each

Trios: \$50 each

## THE FINE PRINT

- We will do our best to select one of your song suggestions but cannot guarantee it for numerous reasons.
- Please also remember that the choreographer you request is unfortunately NOT guaranteed either. Miss Abigail will determine your choreographer based on availability, style of movement and of course your request.
- Dancers are responsible for purchasing their own costume & props if applicable. They are also responsible for bringing all props and pieces to and from competition events.
- Rehearsals will only be held on Friday evenings, Saturdays and Sundays since the studios are not available any evening before 9/9:30pm. Be sure to declare conflicts on your form and if you are available during vacations this is helpful as well.
- All competition fees must be paid to AFDS 6 weeks in advance of the competition.
- These solo/duet/trio pieces will only perform at competitions. The June recitals are too long and not the correct venue to showcase individual dancers. If the AFDS faculty feels a particular piece did overwhelming well at competition it MAY be chosen to perform at the recitals. This means that if you want family to see this piece you must invite them to attend competition or buy the dvd of your dance which is sometimes available at the competition lobby booths.
